Percentage of UK population participating in last 12 months

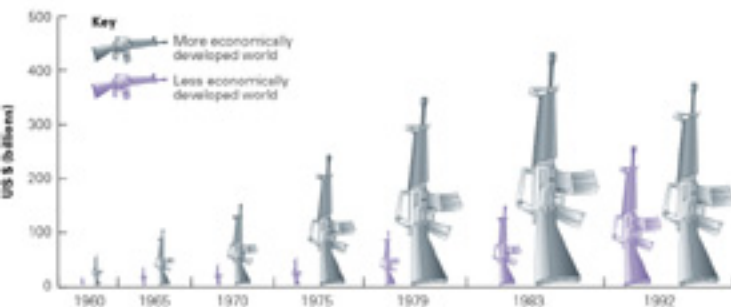
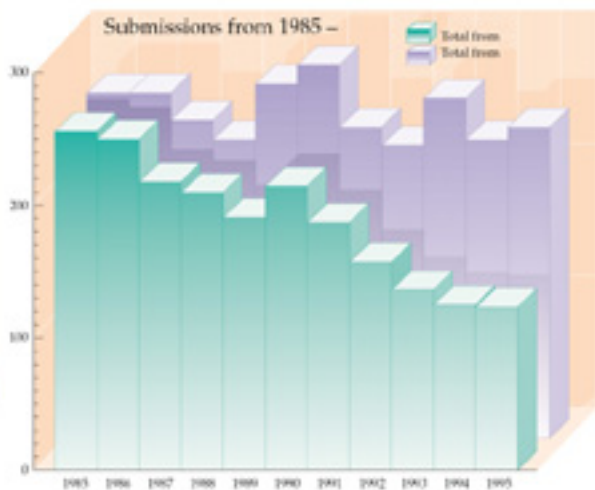
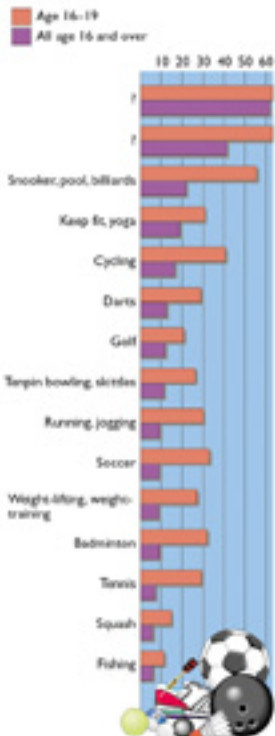
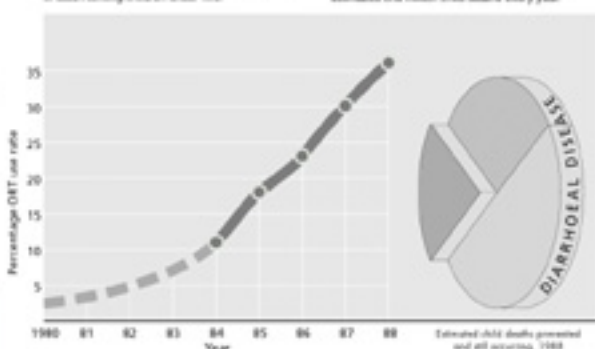


Fig. 5 The spread of oral rehydration therapy

Low cost oral rehydration therapy (ORT) can be used to prevent or treat the dehydration, caused by diarrhoea, which is the single most common cause of death among children under-five.

Almost unknown at the beginning of this decade, ORT is now being used by one in three of the developing world's families and is preventing an estimated one million child deaths every year.



For the purposes of this chart, ORT includes the use of both sachets of oral rehydration salts (known as ORS), recommended mainly for the treatment of dehydration, and also home-made solutions of salt and sugar or other foods which are recommended for the prevention of dehydration.
